

EGHS Board Meeting Minutes - October 13, 2014

Call to Order: EGHS President Barbara Claire

Announcements: Jim Entrican is the 2014 Mayor's Volunteer Award winner in the category of Arts, Culture, and Heritage. Congratulations, Jim!

Minutes: Minutes of September 8 were approved as submitted.

Treasurer's Report: We received a \$10,000 donation from the Wightman family. So far we've received \$2,065 from the Barn Raising Fundraiser. The Antique and Craft Show netted \$1,876. The Board approved bills totaling \$435.32 to be paid and the Treasurer's report was approved as submitted.

Committee Reports:

- Annual Antique & Craft Show The event went very well and exceeded income over last year. We received lots
 of favorable comments from vendors.
- ♦ Docents High school students are doing a great job at the Haunted Stage Stop.
- Giant Pumpkin Festival & Haunted Stage Stop Attendance has been very good and over the weekend there were some larger groups who came through, many who were first timers. The pumpkin house (gazebo) is a big hit for little ones. Advertising in various ways has paid off and Good Day Sacramento came and filmed on the first day.
- Old Fashioned Christmas Jeanette Lawson will not be chairing this event next year. However, she will be happy to train someone to take over. If anyone is interested, please let her know and they can work with her this year.
- Scout Projects—lim Entrican is coordinating several ongoing projects.

Unfinished Business:

- Foulks House Restoration and Blacksmith Shop/Storage Shed Jim met with a new contractor. He has a couple of cement companies in Elk Grove who would be willing to donate the cement work to defray some of the costs.
- Front Porch Repair/Fountain Jim is working with this same contractor and expects to get a quote soon.
- The fountain continues to tip. Jim will contact the Secret Garden for a recommendation to get this resolved.

New Business:

- ♦ There will be a meeting about the Whitelock Parkway project on October 29, 6-9 PM at the Pavilion in Elk Grove Park. It is open to the public.
- Annaclare Entrican's family would like to donate an heirloom Wedgewood stove to the Society. They would like to have it placed on display in the Elk Grove House and suggested it replace the current stove in the kitchen. That one could then be moved to the Blacksmith Shop. This donation is contingent upon the stove being kept here and not being sold. Barbara asked Sally to send a letter of acknowledgement and appreciation.
- Milt Webb asked about having a work/trash day soon. He would like to keep the horse drawn plows. We will discuss this at the next meeting. In addition, Milt would like to see a timeline for starting the shed and restoration of the Foulks House.

President Barbara Claire adjourned the meeting.
