



EGHS Board Meeting Minutes - August 12, 2013

Call to Order: EGHS President Barbara Claire

- Minutes of June 10 were approved as submitted. (There was no meeting in July.)
- Board approved: Purchase of wallpaper and supplies for the dining room, \$600. The decorator will provide new drapes and chair coverings at no cost. Payment of \$2,500 to Ed Keema for the time capsule; pay Clarke & Rush for work done on the A/C unit, \$488; plumbing for kitchen at \$3,800 to hire a plumber to dig a ditch to make a connection, clean the pipe, install a pump station and install a 20-gallon water heater.
- The Wightman sisters have donated \$10,000 to the Society.

Treasurer's report was approved as submitted.

Committee Reports

- Antique and Craft Show So far 22 vendors have signed up with more expected.
- Bylaws and Policy and Procedures are being revised.
- Cookbooks We had 200 copies reprinted and are available.
- Haunted Stage Stop Decorating will begin September 14.
- Yard Sale We grossed \$5,044.80, \$342 from the silent auction. Thanks to everyone who helped.

Unfinished Business

- Landscaping and Sprinklers Jim fixed the sprinkler at no cost. The plan to put stepping stones to the
 roses by the front fence was changed because of the cost and the area was filled in with bark. GOTG
 have completed their work on the raised kitchen garden, but will continue to prune the rose bushes,
 etc.
- Foulks House Restoration/Architect The architect was paid after we received the \$5,000 grant from the City.
- Storage Shed Jim met with the architect about drawing up plans for the storage shed. He has also talked to the Scouts about helping to build up the area and lay a concrete foundation. Other Scout projects could be framing, insulation, and sheetrock.
- Security System Jim received two proposals for upgrading/replacing our security system. It was agreed to table making a decision until further negotiations with Tyco Integrated Security.

New Business

• Elk Grove registered Livestock Brands - Sarah Johnson had a request from Howard Sihner who has been in contact with the State Brand Inspector's Office and learned that there are about 60 Brands registered in the Elk Grove area and some 460 in the State. Since these Brands are a historical resource, he was wondering if the Historical Preservation Committee and the Historical Society would like to join them in this endeavor. Sarah said she is not asking for someone to do anything, just looking for more information for him if we know of any Brands. Dennis said he plans on attending the meeting.

President Barbara Claire adjourned the meeting.
