EGHS Board Meeting Minutes - August 10, 2015

- ◆ Call to order: Brookelea Lutton (President)
- ◆ **Public Comment:** Jason Lofton/Jim Entrican Historical Sims Ranch: Jim introduced Mr. Lofton, Sr. Civil Engineer, SRCSD. He provided pictures and background information on the Sims House and Nicholas Dairy both dating from the late 1800's. Jim would like the Society to consider being involved historically.
- ♦ Announcements: The Sheldon Family Association Tour of the museum on July 31st went well.
- ♦ **Approval of Minutes:** July 13, 2015--Diane Borden (Recording Secretary):
- ◆ Treasurer's Report/Bills--Jeanette Lawson (Treasurer): Brookelea reported that the Wightman sisters donated \$10,000 and an acknowledgement/thank you has been sent. <u>Bills:</u> \$310.13 – SMUD bill, \$ 216.00 to Paula Maita to have blocks inscribed for the Time Capsule project. Bills and the Treasurer's Report were approved.
- Rhoads School Update—Sharon Baker: Sharon reported that 10 reservations have been received and they have two new docents, for a total of 7. They will be cleaning the school on September 15th.
- <u>CSD Update</u>—Rich Lozano: There have been questions about the fire fighters assigned to various fires in the state as to whether they are paid by CSD. Rich said CSD is reimbursed by the State. Rich reported that the Park Naming Committee, met on July 13th to decide on two parks to be developed in the future. He is pleased to announce that one park will be named after the Kammerer family and the other will be named the Jim and Annaclare Saner Entrican Park.

Committee Reports:

- ♦ Membership—Lorraine Croup: Welcome to new member Louis & Sherri Silveira and George & Maria Gould and Maureen Gomley.
- Policy & Procedure Committee—Brookelea Lutton: The duties for event and support positions are being written.
- <u>Fall Craft Show</u>—Brookelea Lutton: Brookelea has received 34 applications from vendors and she hopes to have
- Old Fashioned Christmas—Brookelea Lutton: Brookelea is still searching for a decorator for the dining room.
- Haunted Stage Stop—Jeanette Lawson: It was decided not to have a booth at the Giant Pumpkin Festival, but information will be available at the Rhoads School.
- ◆ Yard Sale Wrap-up—Lorraine Croup: Estimated Income: \$6,778.36, Expenses \$300.00, Net Income: \$6,478.36 Unfinished Business:
- ♦ Grant Requests—Barbara Claire: We received our official agreement from the City of Elk Grove for the Tom Russell Library grant, total amount of \$8,210, and also the Event Sponsorship awards: \$1,000 cash for the Haunted Stage Stop, \$1,500 cash, plus in kind support for the Antique Flea Market and Vintage Trailer Show, total amount around \$4,800. Also notification of awards for 2015-2016 from CSD for the community support grants for equipment usage grants for the 2016 Spring Tea, the 2016 Yard Sale and the 2016 Craft Show.
- <u>Foulks House Restoration and Blacksmith Shop/Storage Shed</u>—Jim Entrican: Jim will make a call before the next meeting and provide a status. The storage shed plans have to be completed first (pro bono) and no money has been committed or approved to build it.
- Scout Projects—lim Entrican: lim reported that 6 out of 10 are a "go" and has 9 potential projects in the works.
- <u>Tentative Wine Auction by Bob Harris (fundraiser)</u>—Sharon Baker: After discussion it was agreed that it would not be a good fit for the Society to use as a fundraiser.
- Reese School Committee—Brookelea Lutton/all: On July 16, 2015, a draft letter was reviewed by the Board to send to Montgomery regarding their offer to sell the beams to us for \$8,500. Our response offered \$5,000 instead and was approved by a majority vote of the Board. Montgomery countered our offer with \$6,500 to buy their beams. A letter was sent to Montgomery acknowledging receipt of the counter offer stating that we would be in touch after our August 10th Board meeting. Carol received estimates for demolition at \$9,200-\$15,000 not including permits or environmental reports. The Board has been requested to make a decision whether to accept the counter offer from Montgomery in the amount of \$6,500. It was moved by Jim Entrican and seconded by Diane Borden to pay Montgomery \$6,500 for the beams. A vote was taken which resulted in a tie, 3 to 3, with one abstention. In conclusion, Brookelea said that another vote would be taken when all Board members are present.

New Business:

♦ Elections—Brookelea Lutton: A slate of our 6 elected officers needs to be presented in October

The meeting was adjourned by President Brookelea Lutton at 6:40 PM.
