Old Business:

- 1. **City inspection** Tom met with the city inspector and everything is okay for our April 12th opening. David Storer, new society member and Assistant City Manager, was also at the inspection. There should be no problems; we need a pipe handrail on the disabled walk and a sign that says "STEP DOWN" at the back door, which we will have before the opening.
- 2. Basement office Sandi reported that the acoustical paneling to hopefully do two wall has been delivered, but she hasn't gotten them installed yet. Carmel & Dorothy volunteered to take the doors that have been stored in the basement out and power wash, sand and paint them. Then people can paint pictures on them and we can hinge a couple of doors together to make office dividers.
- 3. **Grant request from City of Elk Grove** Tom reported that he delivered the grant request to the city the day before it was due. We asked for \$3200.
- 4. Tour of Homes Lucille reported that the tour will start at Yvonne Bonache's home, then go to the McConnell Winery, the back to the hotel for lunch, then on to the Lent home and finally (hopefully) to the Rosebud. They have reserved the bus for the first weekend in October. The complete tour will run from about 9 a.m. until about 4 or 5 p.m. The bus will hold 45 and they may charge \$45. They haven't determined the lunch menu yet, and will report on that at the next meeting.
